Dr. Kevin T. Brady is the president and founder of the American Institute for History Education, a position he has held since 2003.

The holder of a doctorate in history from Temple University in Philadelphia, Pa., He has been an author, contributing author or consultant for numerous articles and interactive CD-ROMs on the subjects of teaching history and developing curricula for various levels of education. From 1999 to 2004 he was a member of the board of trustees for the New Jersey Council for History Education. Dr. Brady was the director of the Rutgers/LEAP Academy University High School in Camden, N.J., and director of the Institute for Best Practices and Innovations in Urban Education, Center for Strategic Urban Community Leadership at Rutgers University's Camden Campus from 2002 to 2003. Dr. Brady is currently on the board of directors for the New Jersey Council for the Social Studies.

His understanding of the needs of secondary education providers comes from his own experience teaching at the high school level. From 1993 through 2000 Dr. Brady taught high school Social Studies at several southern New Jersey schools including Camden Catholic High School (Cherry Hill, N.J.), Kingsway Regional High School (Woolwich Twp., N.J.), and West Deptford High School (Westville, N.J.).
