# Kids for Clean Communities - Clean Teens '08 Awards

## How have you made New Jersey clean and litter-free?

The Trustees of the New Jersey Clean Communities Council invite you to participate in our Kids for Clean Communities - Clean Teens Seminar & Awards Program, May 21, 2008, at Jadwin Gymnasium on the Campus of Princeton University. The program is designed especially for people under the ages of eighteen. We hope you will join us. It's our way of saying "thank you" to people who have made New Jersey clean and litter-free.

### Eligibility

- Nominee may be a school or youth group comprised of people under the ages of eighteen; or an individual under the age of eighteen. The school or youth group must be based in New Jersey; the individual must reside in New Jersey. You may nominate your own program or project, or that of another entity. Awards are considered based on the ages of the participants.
- Nominee must have implemented an educational program or project related to litter abatement and the proper handling of solid waste. Topics may include but not be limited to litter abatement, reuse, recycling, source reduction, non point source reduction, and beautification (combined with litter abatement). Examples of projects include participation in cleanups; or production of art, essays, poetry, photography, video or other media.
- The award application must include a one-page summary of the program or project. Application may be documented with description, press clips, photos, audio-visual materials, or other pertinent information. Any school, youth or individual nominated for an award will be recognized. Top awards will be presented for outstanding achievements. Our most prestigious award is the \$1,000 scholarship presented by the New Jersey Food Council.

Special consideration will be given to programs or projects that are—

- ongoing,
- innovative, and
- demonstrate measurable impact.

To be recognized, complete the application form and write a one-page description of the piece of trash, including documentation such as a photo. You may bring the piece of trash with you to the awards program.
