The individual must also understand New Jersey policies and procedures, with the ability to work with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, as well as county and municipal government and school districts, to encourage participation in litter-abatement activities.

Responsibilities include:

- Providing strategic leadership to advance the Council's mission, vision and grassroots goals
- Executing strong relationships within the public and private sector to embrace the NJCCC mission
- Developing a solid fundraising plan, pulling in various constituencies for support
- Managing budgets, working with the state DEP on approvals
- Creating an innovative advertising and media communications campaign
- Writing compelling, well-developed proposals and executing contracts
- Speaking to school and community groups to educate them on anti-litter messages
- Supervising a small staff and vendors
- Creating innovative programming that attracts youth
- Managing all facets of events throughout the year, including seminars, education programs and a spring conference

Additional Background:

NJCCC is under contract to the NJ Department of Environmental Protection to collect statistical reports from 556 municipalities and 21 counties. The council must file a report to the Governor and Legislature annually. NJCCC also administers New Jersey's Adopt-a-Beach and Adopt-a-Highway programs.
